NOTES & INSTRUCTIONS

Please read these notes and instructions carefully before completing this application form. Be sure to read every section and that the information you provide is accurate.

1. You must supply all the information requested, or explain why you cannot provide it.
2. Students do not have to pay back any bursary funds. However, after completion of the 2-week Introductory Course of Horsemanship, all bursary students will be required to complete a minimum of 400 hours of community service work with a registered equine welfare (or other animal welfare), child welfare or other approved* non-profit program in their home country within a 24-month period.

Bursary recipients who emigrate from their country of residence before completing their community service hours, or who do not successfully complete their community service hours within a 24-month period, will be required to pay back a portion of the cost of their bursary program (based on a rate of ZAR 150 / USD 12 per hour of community service not completed).

*All community service programs must be officially registered with their home country and will be vetted and approved by the Horses 4 Hope board.
3. All bursary recipients will be required to maintain a high standard of personal conduct, good ethics, non-violent behaviour and strong morals.
4. All short-listed bursary candidates will be required to prove their financial need.
5. The following documents must accompany your application:
 - Passport
 - National Identity Document
 - Passport sized photograph
 - Most recent academic transcript / certificate
 - At least one equine-related letter of reference

For your information we wish to advise you that our selection process on acceptance of your application consists of two video interviews.
